

WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE:

- ✓ actor
- ✓ playwright (=scrittore di opere teatrali)
- ✓ he acted (= ha recitato) in different companies (= compagnie teatrali)

- He created many famous **characters** (= personaggi)



- Shakespeare's characters → are **real** people

↓
they are like us (= come noi),

they aren't perfect and

they **make mistakes** (= fanno errori)

- Themes
 - love
 - friendship (=amicizia)
 - vengeance (=vendetta)

SHAKESPEARE'S LIFE

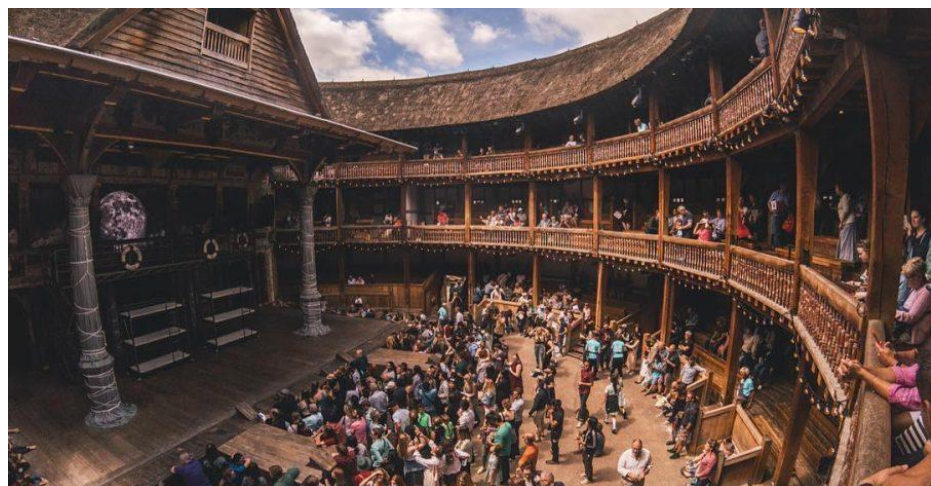
- He was born in Stratford-upon-Avon (= dal nome del fiume) in 1564
- He married (= ha sposato) Anne Hathaway when he was 18 and they had three children
- By (=entro il) 1592 he worked as (=come) an actor in London and then he started writing plays (=opere teatrali)

- He wrote (= ha scritto)
 - comedies (= have a happy ending)
 - tragedies (= have a sad ending)
 - historical plays
 - poems

- Ex. of comedies = *A Midsummer Night's Dream* (= Sogno di una notte di mezza estate); *the Merchant of Venice* (= il mercante di Venezia);
- Ex. of tragedies = *Hamlet*, *Romeo and Juliet*;
- Ex. of historical plays = *King Lear*, *Macbeth*;
- Ex. of poems (= poesie): *the Sonnets*

about love and women

- He built (= ha costruito) *The Globe Theatre* in London in 1599



- He died (= è morto) in Stratford-upon-Avon in 1616

ROMEO AND JULIET (1594-1596)

- ✓ Verona (= place)
- ✓ Shakespeare (= author)
- ✓ Love story between two young people

↓
tragedy



CHARACTERS

- Prince Escalus (= principe della Scala): Prince of Verona
- Montagues (= Montecchi): Lord and Lady Montague are Romeo's parents
- Mercutio = best friend's Romeo
- Benvolio = Romeo's cousin
- Friar (= frate) Lawrence
- Capulets (= Capuleti): Lord and Lady Capulet are Juliet's parents
- Tybalt (= Tebaldo) = Juliet's cousin
- Juliet's nurse (= balia, nutrice)
- Paris (= Paride) = Juliet's fiancé (= fidanzato)

PLOT (=TRAMA)

- The Capulets and the Montagues are two powerful families in Verona

↓
they hate each other (= si odiano a vicenda) and always fight (= combattono)



- One day Lord Capulet plans (= organizza) a party → he hopes (= spera) that Count Paris (= il conte Paride) will marry (= sposerà) Juliet
- Romeo goes to the party with his cousin, Benvolio, and his best friend, Mercutio, wearing (= indossando) masks

↓
WHY?

Romeo wants to see Rosaline → a girl he is in love with (= una ragazza di cui è innamorato)

- But when Romeo goes to the party, he sees (= vede) Juliet for the first time

↓
they fall in love each other
(= s'innamorano l'uno dell'altra)

- At the party Tybalt, Juliet's cousin, sees Romeo and promise to get revenge (= di vendicarsi)

- At the end of the party Juliet finds out (= scopre) **Romeo** is a **Montague** and Romeo finds out **Juliet** is a **Capulet** → they are both sad (= entrambi tristi).
- After (= dopo) the party, Romeo goes back to the Capulet house



he talks to her from the balcony
and they decide to get married
(= decidono di sposarsi)

- The next day Juliet's nurse (= la nutrice) helps her meet (= la aiuta ad incontrare) Romeo at church (= in chiesa).
- At the church Friar Lawrence (= frate Lorenzo)

marries them in secret (= li sposa in segreto)

WHY?

he thinks (= crede) it would bring
peace (= questo avrebbe portato la pace) to

their town



- After the marriage (= dopo il matrimonio), Tybalt and Mercutio start a fight (= iniziano un duello) and Mercutio gets killed (= viene ucciso)



Romeo gets mad (= impazzisce) and
kills Tybalt (= uccide Tebaldo)

- The Prince banishes Romeo (= esilia Romeo) from Verona and he flees to Mantua (= fugge a Mantova)

↓
Juliet cries a lot (= piange molto) → her parents think
she's crying because her cousin Tybalt is dead (= i suoi
genitori pensano che lei stia piangendo perché suo
cugino Tebaldo è morto)

↓
her parents plan Juliet's wedding to
Paris (= i suoi genitori organizzano le nozze di
Giulietta con Paride) in three days



- Juliet goes to Friar Lawrence for help (= per chiedergli aiuto)

↓
he gives her (= le dà) medicine

that would make her look dead (= che l'avrebbe fatta sembrare morta)

- Friar Lawrence sends (= spedisce) a letter to Romeo
so he would know Juliet is
only pretending to be dead (= così lui avrebbe saputo che
Giulietta sta solo fingendo di essere morta)



the letter gets lost
(= la lettera va perduta)

- Romeo thinks (= crede) Juliet is really dead (= è morta davvero)

so he buys poison (= compra del veleno)
to kill himself (= per uccidersi)



he goes to Juliet's tomb and
finds Juliet's body

he takes the poison and dies

- A few minutes after he dies (= alcuni minuti dopo essere morto),
Juliet wakes up (= si sveglia) and sees (= vede) that Romeo is dead

she takes Romeo's
knife (= prende il pugnale di
Romeo) and kills herself

- Juliet's nurse and Friar Lawrence
tell (= raccontano ai) the
Montagues and the Capulets
about the secret marriage (= del matrimonio segreto).





- The Montagues and the Capulets feel so bad (= si sentono così male) that they promise to always be nice to each other (= che promettono di essere sempre gentili l'uno con l'altro)
